CRUISING AWARDS CRITERIA

LONG DISTANCE CRUISES

1. The skipper must be a regular member, cruising aboard any boat as long as he or she is the skipper.
2. Each blue water cruise must be during a single trip and may leave any port and return to any port. Blue water is defined as ocean cruising port to port.
3. If cruising categories are combined, overlapping mileage can only be counted toward one cruise.
4. Contestants must submit a brief written itinerary and map of cruises to the Board prior to 1 December.
5. Chart mileage or GPS mileage may be used in computing cruise distance in nautical miles and a daily record, in terms of mileage A to D via B & C (rhumb line), must be provided to the Board prior to 1 December if he requires such information in order to determine an award winner.

SHORT DISTANCE CRUISES

Contestants must submit a brief note to the Board prior to 1 December, listing the dates of the ECSA cruises in which they participated. Points will be awarded as follows:

- 5 points awarded if arriving by boat
 - 3 points awarded if hosting the cruise
 - 2 points awarded if arriving by land
- (Points are cumulative for each event)
